WHAT'S INVOLVED

BCO Judging Panels are made up of five regional panels and one national panel, each consisting of up to six individuals representing different aspects of the commercial property industry.

Those wishing to become a judge **must be members of the BCO and be aware of the amount of time** required to participate in the judging process and events surrounding the awards. **Judges are expected to attend all visits in their region.** It is imperative that those standing for this position are aware of this commitment before submitting this application.

³ The regional awards launch events will take place after the National Awards presentation in October and is an opportunity for the judges to showcase the regional winners, de-mystify the entry process and encourage entries for the following year.

⁴ The judges de-brief event is hosted by the National Judging Chair and attended by the Regional Judging Chairs to discuss the results of the National Judging and give feedback on all aspects of the awards/judging process.
